Donate a Dime a Day

Thank you to the Valley families who have participated so far in this year's Dime a Day campaign. The Dime a Day campaign is the Foundation's annual giving campaign. We know, during this difficult time in our economy, that every gift is a sacrifice. So when structuring our annual giving program, we were deliberate to create options that could fit every budget — that could allow every family to participate at the level that worked best for them.

One dime a day is \$18 for the whole year. There are 180 days in the school year. There are about 720 students at the school. If every student donated one dime for every day of school we could raise \$12,960 for Valley. That's a lot of computers or iPads for our students and teachers. But for each one of us, it's just a dime.

WOULD YOU LIKE TO BRING HOME YOUR CHILD'S WORK




